Dear Mr. Morgan:

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated May 17, 2011, requesting that the Department of Labor conduct a Davis-Bacon Act wage survey for the State of Florida. We apologize for any delay in responding. We have been reviewing all aspects of your request in great detail.

The Wage and Hour Division's (WHD) survey plan prioritizes surveys based on the needs in particular areas. The three criteria used to prioritize surveys are: 1) whether the last survey is over two years old; 2) whether federal construction is anticipated in the area; and 3) whether information is received that wage patterns have changed from the current wage determination.

WHD will not conduct a statewide Florida survey in 2012. WHD has targeted January 2013 as the date to initiate a building survey in the State of Florida. We will add your name to our mailing list to receive notification of upcoming surveys. Once we initiate a survey, you may follow the status of each stage of the survey on our website at www.wdol.gov.
